Todd Swingle serves as the Executive Director / CEO for the Toho Water Authority (Toho) in Kissimmee, Florida. Toho serves over 150,000 metered connections with services that include Water, Wastewater, and Reclaimed Water, supporting the residents, businesses and visitors of the City of Kissimmee, City of St. Cloud, Osceola County, and portions of Polk County and Orange County. Mr. Swingle leads a full service organization of approximately 500 employees that operate 26 water and water reclamation facilities, almost 4,000 miles of pipelines, 600 pump stations, and a fully deployed AMI system.

Prior to joining Toho in 2018, Mr. Swingle spent over 25 years serving in various environmental and utilities roles including consulting, service to the global manufacturing company Cummins Inc. as the Manager of Water Programs and Director of Environmental/Organizational Strategy, and public sector roles as Public Services Administrator for the City of St. Cloud, FL and Deputy Director for Orange County, FL Utilities. He is active in a variety of civic and professional organizations focused on community and the environment including currently serving as the Chair for the Brevard County Florida Save Our Indian River Lagoon Citizen Oversight Committee. Professionally, Mr. Swingle currently serves as a board member for the National Association of Clean Water Agencies, the Association of Metropolitan Water Agencies, the Water Research Foundation, and the Florida Water Environment Association Utility Council.

Mr. Swingle holds Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Environmental Engineering from the University of Central Florida and an MBA from the University of Florida. He is also a registered Professional Engineer.
