MICHAEL PERRONE

National President, Professional Aviation Safety Specialists, AFL-CIO

Michael Perrone began his term as national president of the Professional Aviation Safety Specialists, AFL-CIO (PASS) in October 2012 after serving as the union's vice president since 2003. PASS represents approximately 11,000 FAA employees in five separate bargaining units throughout the United States and in several foreign locations.

After serving in the United States Air Force for five years, Perrone joined the FAA in 1981. He began his career in air traffic control before working as a radar technician. Most recently, Perrone has worked as an FAA systems specialist at TF Green Airport in Rhode Island and Bradley Airport in Connecticut.

Perrone joined PASS in 1994 and, prior to becoming PASS's national vice president, worked in a variety of union roles, including PASS national assistant and PASS liaison to several FAA programs and involvement in training, engineering and system design.
