Complex Capital Improvement Projects have included:

2006, Camarillo Airport – Transfer of proprietary well water system and connection to City water system with little direct cost to the County in exchange for permitting development of an outlet mall near the airport by modifying a restrictive airport easement. Project seen as a "win-win-win".

2010, Oxnard Airport – Relocation of a displaced threshold to gain approximately 925 feet of landing distance to provide 5,500 feet of landing distance on a 6,000 foot runway, making the airport capable of accepting regional jet fleet mix in hope of providing more effective air service. The project was unanimously supported, including by the Cultural Heritage Board on behalf of the Oxnard Historic District which lies directly under the approach path of the airport runway.

2010, Camarillo Airport – Construction of full length parallel taxiway in location of future parallel runway. An immediate need existed to provide two way taxi capability for aircraft at the airport and to meet necessary wing tip clearance for the critical aircraft, but the location for the taxiway depicted on the Airport Master Plan was not viable due to a navigation aid lying in its path. Taxiway was constructed in location of future utility runway, in a manner that it can easily be converted to a runway when demand requires it.

Deputy Director of Airports - Under the direction of the Director of Airports, was responsible for the day to day operations and facilities management of two County airports (CMA and OXR); responsible for the security requirements at Part 139 and GA reliever airports; responsible for lease management for airline and terminal concessions, airport business park, and airside businesses; worked closely with airlines to ensure adequate counter space, optimal layout for the queuing of passenger screening, and arrival procedures to minimize noise impacts
