Lee Page is the Senior Associate Advocacy Director for the Paralyzed Veterans of America (PVA). For the past 30 years, Lee has been a disability rights advocate for PVA members and all people with disabilities.

As part of his outreach, Lee works with the Consortium for Constituents with Disabilities (CCD). CCD is the largest coalition of national organizations working together to advocate for people disabilities in all aspects of society. He is a former a co-chair of the CCD Transportation and Long-Term Services and Supports task forces.

Lee was a founding member of the ITEM Coalition to ensure health insurance coverage of durable medical equipment and complex rehabilitative technology in Medicare and currently sits on the Coalitions' Steering Committee. Lee did extensive work to ensure the passage of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the National Voter Registration Act, the Help America Vote Act, and other legislation affecting disability rights.

In 2016, Lee was appointed to the Department of Transportation's Advisory Committee on Accessible Air Transportation (ACCESS Advisory Committee). He is a subject matter expert on compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and the Air Carrier Access Act (ACAA).

By advocating for the removal of regulatory and discriminatory barriers, Lee continues to work for passage and implementation of legislation that will enrich the lives of paralyzed veterans and all people with disabilities.

PVA is a national nonprofit veterans service organization dedicated to meeting the needs of its members, veterans of military service who are paralyzed as a result of spinal cord injury or disease.
