In 2021, Greg Regan was elected President of the Transportation Trades Department, AFL-CIO (TTD). As America's largest transportation labor federation, TTD represents 37 unions and millions of transportation workers across aviation, transit, rail, maritime, construction, manufacturing, and other industries.

Mr. Regan serves as the organization's chief policy strategist, and a leading labor expert on issues related to aviation safety and security. Under Mr. Regan's leadership, TTD advocates for federal policies that will invest in U.S. transportation systems and the workers who keep them moving.
