

Agencies have the discretion to purchase our services utilizing this schedule and many have done so throughout the past three years via the acceptance of tenders or purchase orders from FedEx. In addition, the Department of Defense also utilizes many tenders, all of which are tied to the GSA Multiple Award Schedule.

2. FedEx Express, a subsidiary of FedEx Corporation, was awarded Long Range International Air Transportation Services Contracts with the Air Mobility Command of the U.S. Department of the Air Forces to make aircraft available to the Civil Reserve Air Fleet during fiscal years 2012, 2013, and 2014.

3. FedEx Express entered into a new seven-year agreement (beginning September 2013) with the United States Postal Service for airport-to-airport transportation.
