

Captain Christopher Turner is a 20-year veteran of the Kansas Highway Patrol, second generation serving as a KHP trooper as his father did. He oversees the Kansas Highway Patrol's Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program (MCSAP), motor carrier inspector weight enforcement, fixed and mobile scales and the Patrol's accident reconstruction teams.
