As an immigration attorney, Larry litigated hundreds of cases in state and federal courts. He last practiced with the Florence Project, the only nonprofit organization that provides free legal services to men, women, and children in immigration detention in Arizona. In addition to direct representation, Larry led the pro bono program, doubling the size and reach of the program as well as traveling around the state teaching legal education courses on the intersection of state and federal law. He was awarded the Randy Tunac Courage in Immigration award by his fellow practitioners for exceptional advocacy in the field of immigration.

Larry later served in the office of Congressman Greg Stanton, where he directed strategic outreach as well as provided advice on immigration, refugee, and border policy. He also led Latino engagement for the Biden for President campaign in Arizona.

Larry now works in higher education policy, seeking new and innovative ways to increase access to higher ed for Latino and first-generation college students.
