

**Tim Duit** began taking on summer jobs at family owned Duit Construction when he was still in middle school, working his way up the ranks.

He was given the position of foreman in 1988. In 1994, Tim started his own company, TTK Construction Co., and in 2017, the firm merged with Duit Construction, and he was named president.

Under his leadership, Tim has grown the company into a team of over 800 employees, making it one of Oklahoma's largest heavy highway paving contractors.

The firm specializes in delivering quality, award-winning, complex paving projects. The project portfolio includes road, bridge, and underground construction for the federal government, cities, counties, airports, and rail companies. In 2019, Tim co-directed the construction team that won the bid to construct Oklahoma's first P3 highway project and the largest project in the state's history.

Duit's volunteer leadership roles within the American Road & Transportation Builders Association (ARTBA) include senior vice chair (2023); strategic planning committee member (2023); first vice chair (2020-22); strategic planning committee co-chair (2020); FAST Act Reauthorization Task Force Committee co-chair (2019); vice chair at-large (2017-19); president, Contractors Division (2016); and first vice president, Contractors Division (2015). He is also past president of the Association of Oklahoma General Contractors (2008) and a board member (2004-07).

Tim served on the Oklahoma AGC Workers' Compensation board of directors and is currently on the executive committee and board of directors for The Road Information Program (TRIP).

He is a graduate of the University of Central Oklahoma with a Bachelor of Business Administration in business management.
