

Al Davis was appointed Deputy Director of TEEX on May 1, 2014 by the Board of Regents of The Texas A&M University System. He previously served as the Director of the National Emergency Response and Recovery Training Center (NERRTC). Mr. Davis brings significant professional experience to this position having served as a program coordinator, director of training, and director for NERRTC where he provided fiscal oversight of a multi-million dollar training program that reaches across the United States. He works closely with federal partners to ensure current and future programs meet national level training needs, remain relevant to state and local communities, and address emerging threats and hazards.

He serves as Chairman of the National Domestic Preparedness Consortium (NDPC) and Co-founder and Principal Member Emeritus of the National Cyber Security Preparedness Consortium (NCPC). He is a former advisory board member of the National Center for Spectator Sports Safety and Security (NCS4). His position requires that he work cross functionally with the operational divisions and administrative entities of the agency.

Prior to his employment with TEEX in 2005, he worked as a consultant with United Water and, chief executive of the Public School District in New Orleans. He served in the United States Marine Corps and retired at the rank of colonel.

Mr. Davis has earned a Bachelor's Degree in Marketing from Southern University; a Master's Degree in National Resource Strategy from the National Defense University; and an MBA from Averett University.
