**William F. Downey** is Executive Vice President of Corporate Affairs and Chief Security Officer (CSO) for the Kenan Advantage Group (KAG). In his role, Mr. Downey is responsible for corporate security, human resources and government affairs. He joined KAG as Vice President and CSO following the 9/11 attacks. Since then, he has developed Crisis Management and Security Plans (pre-HM232), adopted technology to enhance security corporate-wide, and integrated extensive security training to include the Highway Watch initiative. He worked with TSA/General Dynamics on a truck tracking pilot which led to components of KAG's Security Program being used by TSA in its training modules.

Mr. Downey is a Past Chairman of American Trucking Associations' (ATA) Homeland Security Policy Committee and a member and past chair of ATA's Supply Chain Security and Loss Prevention Council.

He retired after 30 years of investigative and management experience with the Federal Bureau of Investigation. In the wake of the Columbine tragedy in 1999, he served as Executive Director for one of Ohio's largest school systems, establishing building design criteria for enhanced security and school security procedures which are still used today. Mr. Downey has participated in FBI and U.S. Secret Service after-incident reviews of school-based violence and has completed U.S. Secret Service Threat Assessment training.

Mr. Downey served as a member of a FMCSA expert panel that evaluates security technology; a charter member of the Highway & Motor Carrier Sector Coordinating Council; and on the Pandemic Working Group. He has participated in numerous Transportation Security table top exercises; provided onsite recovery advice to FEMA and GSA post Hurricane Katrina; and participated on numerous panels regarding transportation security with the insurance industry, state and federal agencies and numerous insurance carriers.
