Scot Naparstek was named the EVP & COO for Amtrak in January, 2017. As COO, Scot has responsibility for the success of all Amtrak Operations including Transportation, Engineering and Mechanical. This includes leadership of 17,000 employees and a budget in excess of \$2 Billion inclusive of operating and capital funds. Prior to assuming the COO role, Scot held the position of Senior Vice President of Operations (SVPO) from December 2013. As the SVPO, Scot also assumed two interim roles. First he was assigned as Interim Chief Engineer from September 2014 to June 2015. The second interim assignment was Interim Deputy General Manager of the Mid-Atlantic Division for the North East Corridor (NEC) Business Line. He held this position from August 2015 to December 2015.

Scot originally joined Amtrak as the Director Corporate Human Capital Business Partners in May 2012 and in September 2012, he was also appointed leader for Amtrak Labor and Employee Relations.

Prior to joining Amtrak, Scot had extensive experience in Operations Management, Engineering and Human Resources with companies such as Cummins Engine Company, ABB Inc. and Titan America.
