Effective May 1st, 2017, Jack Dinsdale was elected TCU Vice President by the TCU/IAM Executive Council to replace the position of retiring Vice President Tom Truhler. He was elected to a full term as National Vice President at TCU's 35th Regular Convention in July, 2018.
