After graduation, Andy became the fourth generation in his family to work for CSX or its predecessor railroads. He started out as a craft employee in Lima, Ohio before moving into management as a front line supervisor in Toledo, Ohio in January of 2001. In 2006, he was promoted to Director of Train Operations in Network Operations in the CSX dispatch office in Chicago. After four years in the dispatch center, Andy was offered the opportunity to run his own terminal in Philadelphia. During his time in Philadelphia, Andy managed three different rail yards in addition to line of road operations. After four years in Philadelphia, Andy was asked to return to lead the Dispatch office he had previously worked in as the Superintendent of Operations in Chicago, a role he held for six years. In October of 2017, Andy was promoted to lead the Passenger Operations team in Jacksonville. While in this role, Andy was instrumental in leading drastic operational improvements in the performance of passenger trains operating on CSX's network, taking Amtrak on-time performance from the sub 70s to consistently above 90%.
