RESOLUTION

Providing for authority to initiate litigation for actions by the President inconsistent with his duties under the Constitution of the United States.

- 1 Resolved, That the Speaker may initiate or intervene
- in one or more civil actions on behalf of the House of Rep-
- resentatives in a Federal court of competent jurisdiction
- to seek relief pursuant to sections 2201 and 2202 of title
- 28, United States Code, and to seek appropriate ancillary
- relief, including injunctive relief, regarding the failure of
- the President, the head of any department or agency, or
- any other officer or employee of the United States, to act

- 1 in a manner consistent with that official's duties under
- 2 the Constitution and laws of the United States with re-
- 3 spect to implementation of (including a failure to imple-
- 4 ment) any provision of the Patient Protection and Afford-
- 5 able Care Act and title I and subtitle B of title II of the
- 6 Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010,
- 7 including any amendment made by such provision.
- 8 Sec. 2. The Speaker shall notify the House of Rep-
- 9 resentatives of a decision to initiate or intervene in any
- 10 civil action pursuant to this resolution.
- 11 Sec. 3. The Office of the General Counsel of the
- 12 House of Representatives, at the direction of the Speaker
- 13 shall represent the House in any civil action initiated, or
- 14 in which the House intervenes, pursuant to this resolution
- 15 and may employ the services of outside counsel and other
- 16 experts for this purpose.
