- 6 ation of the bill are waived. An amendment in the nature

- 5 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of

- 7 waived. Clause 2(e) of rule XXI shall not apply during
- 8 consideration of the bill. The previous question shall be
- 9 considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
- 10 further amendment thereto, to final passage without inter-
- 11 vening motion except: (1) 90 minutes of debate equally
- 12 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
- 13 member of the Committee on Appropriations; (2) the fur-
- 14 ther amendments described in section 2 of this resolution;
- 15 (3) the amendments en bloc described in section 3 of this
- 16 resolution; and (4) one motion to recommit with or with-
- 17 out instructions.
- 18 Sec. 2. After debate pursuant to the first section of
- 19 this resolution, each further amendment printed in part
- 20 B of the report of the Committee on Rules not earlier con-
- 21 sidered as part of amendments en bloc pursuant to section
- 22 3 of this resolution shall be considered only in the order
- 23 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
- 24 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
- 25 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally

- 1 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
- 2 may be withdrawn by the proponent at any time before
- 3 the question is put thereon, shall not be subject to amend-
- 4 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
- 5 of the question.
- 6 Sec. 3. It shall be in order at any time after debate
- 7 pursuant to the first section of this resolution for the chair
- 8 of the Committee on Appropriations or her designee to
- 9 offer amendments en bloc consisting of further amend-
- 10 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee
- 11 on Rules accompanying this resolution not earlier disposed
- 12 of. Amendments en bloc offered pursuant to this section
- 13 shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for 30 min-
- 14 utes equally divided and controlled by the chair and rank-
- 15 ing minority member of the Committee on Appropriations
- 16 or their respective designees, shall not be subject to
- 17 amendment, and shall not be subject to a demand for divi-
- 18 sion of the question.
- 19 Sec. 4. All points of order against the further amend-
- 20 ments printed in part B of the report of the Committee
- 21 on Rules or amendments en bloc described in section 3
- 22 of this resolution are waived.
- SEC. 5. During consideration of the amendments de-
- 24 scribed in sections 2 and 3 of this resolution, it shall not
- 25 be in order to consider an amendment proposing both a

- 1 decrease in an appropriation designated pursuant to sec-
- 2 tion 251(b)(2)(A)(ii) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
- 3 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985 and an increase in an
- 4 appropriation not so designated, or vice versa.
