RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 276) to rename the Gulf of Mexico as the “Gulf of America”, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 881) to establish Department of Homeland Security funding restrictions on institutions of higher education that have a relationship with Confucius Institutes, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.

1 276) to rename the Gulf of Mexico as the “Gulf of Amer-
2 ica”. All points of order against consideration of the bill
3 are waived. The amendment in the nature of a substitute
4 recommended by the Committee on Natural Resources
5 now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The
6 bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points
7 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
8 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
9 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-
10 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion
11 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-
12 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
13 Committee on Natural Resources or their respective des-
14 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

15 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
16 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 881) to
17 establish Department of Homeland Security funding re-
18 strictions on institutions of higher education that have a
19 relationship with Confucius Institutes, and for other pur-
20 poses. All points of order against consideration of the bill
21 are waived. In lieu of the amendment in the nature of a
22 substitute recommended by the Committee on Homeland
23 Security now printed in the bill, an amendment in the na-
24 ture of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-
25 mittee Print 119–2 shall be considered as adopted. The

1 bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points
2 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
3 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
4 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-
5 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion
6 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-
7 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
8 Committee on Homeland Security or their respective des-
9 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.
