Dr. David Walega is currently the Chief of the Division of Pain Medicine at Northwestern Medicine and the Vice Chair of the Department of Anesthesiology at Northwestern University Feinberg School of Medicine in Chicago where he has been faculty since 2003. He earned his medical doctorate from Wayne State University in Detroit in 1993, and completed an internship in Internal Medicine and a residency in Anesthesiology at Northwestern University, where he also completed a fellowship in Pain Medicine in 1998. He earned a Master of Science in Clinical Investigation in 2013, also at Northwestern.

Dr. Walega has practiced interventional pain medicine for 20 years in both the private and academic practice domains. His clinical interests include enhancing patient safety, novel applications of pain management techniques, and emerging applications of neuromodulation for non-opioid pain management for chronic and cancer related pain disorders, and treatment of vasomotor symptoms from cancer treatment and aging. He is a dedicated medical educator, and holds the rank of Associate Professor at Northwestern University. He has published numerous manuscripts and book chapters on pain related topics, has lectured nationally and internationally, and is a member of the American Medical Association Opioid Task Force an inducted member in the Association of University Anesthesiologists, among many others. His research interests include nerve ablation therapies for knee pain from osteoarthritis, and his research on vasomotor symptom management is currently funded by the National Institute on Aging with an RO1 grant.
