

Reginald Hodges, Biography:

Reginald Hodges is the President of The Training Center of Central Texas, a Texas based trade school that serves the Fort Cavazos community in Harker Heights, Texas. Training students for careers as Medical Technicians, Solar Technicians and Electricians. Reginald Hodges truly believes in service to our country. He served 11 years in the United States Navy as an officer and leader in the Navy's Civil Engineer Corps (Seabees), Reginald left the military to continue his career as a construction manager in 2004. He went on to become one of the first construction managers in the world to build utility scale solar power plants with First Solar in 2009, where he was a construction manager on the three largest solar power plants in the world at the time (the world's first mega solar projects).

After observing both the need and the difficulty in finding skilled solar energy technicians and solar trained electricians, Reginald resigned his job in 2014 to create a trade school for the solar industry. In 2014, he attended graduate school at California Polytechnic State University, where he studied electrical Engineering with an emphasis in solar power. In 2017, Reginald moved to Harker Heights, Texas to start the first trade school in the United States with an emphasis in providing skilled solar technicians and electricians for the burgeoning utility scale solar industry. He later expanded into training for careers in the Allied Medical fields. Reginald Hodges truly recognizes the importance of building tomorrow's next generation, both people and future technology.
