Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Small Business Regu-
- 3 latory Reduction Act".
- 4 SEC. 2. SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION RULEMAKING
- 5 COSTS TO SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS.
- 6 (a) In General.—The Administrator shall ensure
- 7 that the small business regulatory budget for a fiscal year
- 8 is not greater than zero.
- 9 (b) Report.—Not later than 60 days after the last
- 10 day of a fiscal year, the Administrator shall submit to
- 11 Congress a report on any regulations issued by other Fed-
- 12 eral agencies that have an impact on small business con-
- 13 cerns. Such report shall include rules issued during the
- 14 fiscal year preceding and the fiscal year following the date
- 15 of the report and such rules shall be disaggregated by the
- 16 issuing Federal agency.
- 17 (c) SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY BUDGET DE-
- 18 FINED.—In this section, the term "small business regu-

- 1 latory budget" means the cost to small business concerns
- 2 (as defined under section 3 of the Small Business Act (15
- 3 U.S.C. 632)) of rulemaking (including the cost of a new
- 4 rule and any modification to or repeal of a rule) by the
- 5 Administrator of the Small Business Administration.
- 6 SEC. 3. COMPLIANCE WITH CUTGO.
- 7 No additional amounts are authorized to be appro-
- 8 priated to carry out this Act. Such Act shall be carried
- 9 out using amounts otherwise appropriated to the Adminis-
- 10 trator of the Small Business Administration.
