

## Matt Splitter Biography (Short)

Matt Splitter is a 5<sup>th</sup> generation agricultural producer, (farmer), from central Kansas where they grow wheat, corn, soybeans and grain sorghum. Matt and his wife, Janna, exclusively farm over 10,000 acres and custom farm another 3,000 acres seasonally.

Matt currently serves on the FCC Precision Agriculture Connectivity Task Force – Mapping and Analyzing Connectivity on Agricultural Lands Working Group, Kansas Corn Growers Association and other local boards and committees. He has previously served on the Central Prairie Cooperative Board of Directors, Team Marketing Alliance Board of Advisors and Kansas Farm Bureau Young Farmers and Ranchers.

Matt graduated from Kansas State University in 2009 and most recently completed “The Executive Program for Agriculture Producers” at Texas A&M.

In 2021, Matt was awarded “The Horizon Award” by Top Producer and Farm Journal. The award recognizes the top producer under the age of 35 in the nation that demonstrates excellence in the business of farming.
