RE: Full Committee Hearing Titled: “Member Day”

On **Tuesday, May 6, 2025, at 11:00 AM ET**, the Committee on Small Business will hold a hearing titled “**Member Day**.” The hearing will convene in room 2360 of the Rayburn House Office Building. The purpose of this hearing is to invite all Members of Congress to testify before Committee Members on matters within the Committee’s jurisdiction, including specific legislation or topics of importance to their constituencies.

I. Background

Pursuant to section 3(r) of House Resolution 5, each standing committee must hold a Member Day Hearing during the first session of the 119th Congress to receive testimony from Members, Delegates, and the Resident Commissioner on proposed legislation within its jurisdiction.

Small businesses make up 99.9 percent of all businesses in the United States, impacting every district for every Member of Congress. The goal of this hearing is to allow all sitting Members of the House to testify about the issues small businesses in their district face as they advocate for and amplify the voices of small businesses across the country.
