Mr. Dowd served in multiple roles in the U.S. Senate, including as Special Assistant and Deputy Legislative Assistant, and Deputy Political Director for the Senator's Political Action Committee and reelection campaign committee.

Mr. Dowd advised the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) on the implementation of the NATO-Industry Cyber Partnership, a high-level initiative of Heads of State and Government to strengthen collaboration with private sector executives on cybersecurity.

He was a Special Advisor to the Chairman of an industrial metals conglomerate, and the Chancellor of the University of Nebraska Medical Center.
