Kurt Voss is the founder, owner and CEO of AmeriLux Family of Companies and oversees operations at the company's corporate headquarters located in De Pere, Wisconsin. The AmeriLux Family of Companies was founded in 2004 which today employs 350 people and operates as a manufacturer, value-adding distributor, and provider of logistics, transportation, and warehousing services. He has been instrumental in initiating leading-edge practices in leadership principles, employee engagement, and personnel development.

Extensively involved in the Green Bay community, Kurt is a frequently invited guest speaker on business and leadership. He holds positions with many local organizations, including the Board of the Green Bay Packers, the Board of Trustees at St. Norbert College, the Board of Advisors at the Donald J. Schneider School of Business and Economics, the Community Advisory Board for the Medical College of Wisconsin - Green Bay, and is the past Chair of the Board of Directors for the Greater Green Bay Community Foundation.

Perhaps Kurt's most meaningful non-business accomplishment was to conceive of, raise the funds for, and oversee a \$2.8M restoration project of a 130-year-old church on the St. Norbert College Campus in memory of his daughter, Cassie.
