

Moshe Schwartz is Senior Fellow for Acquisition Policy at the National Defense Industrial Association and is president of Etherton & Associates. He has served as executive director of the section 809 Panel (a congressionally mandated Advisory Panel on acquisition reform), senior advisor to the Commission on Wartime Contracting in Iraq and Afghanistan, and advisor for the military at ISAF headquarters in Afghanistan. He spent 15 years providing analysis and legislative support to Congress on acquisition policy and industrial base issues, including at GAO and CRS.

Academically, Moshe was an adjunct instructor at National Defense University's Eisenhower School for National Security and Resource Strategy, and at Carnegie Mellon University's Heinz School of Public Policy.
