

AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 10238
OFFERED BY MR. WIED OF WISCONSIN

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Cybersecurity for
3 Small Businesses Act of 2026”.

4 SEC. 2. INFORMATION AND RESOURCES RELATING TO CY-
5 BERSECURITY MATTERS FOR SMALL BUSI-
6 NESS CONCERNS.

7 The Administrator of the Small Business Administra-
8 tion, in consultation with the Director of the Cybersecurity
9 and Infrastructure Security Agency and the Director of
10 the National Institute of Standards and Technology, shall
11 develop and disseminate information and resources to as-
12 sist small business concerns in strengthening the cyberse-
13 curity infrastructure of such concerns and implementing
14 cybersecurity best practices.

15 SEC. 3. CYBERSECURITY COMPLIANCE INFORMATION.

16 (a) CYBERSECURITY MATURITY MODEL CERTIFI-
17 CATION RESOURCES.—The Administrator of the Small
18 Business Administration, in coordination with the Sec-

1 retary of Defense and other appropriate Federal agencies,
2 shall provide information and resources to a small busi-
3 ness concern seeking to enter into a contract with the Fed-
4 eral Government, or seeking to be a subcontractor on a
5 Federal contract, regarding the Cybersecurity Maturity
6 Model Certification program (or successor program), in-
7 cluding information and resources produced and provided
8 by—

9 (1) the Director of Small and Disadvantaged
10 Business Utilization (established under section 15(k)
11 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 644(k))) for
12 the Department of Defense;

13 (2) the program established under section 1807
14 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal
15 Year 2026 (10 U.S.C. 144 note); or

16 (3) the APEX Accelerator Program of the De-
17 partment of Defense (or a successor program).

18 (b) PUBLICATION.—The Administrator shall include
19 the information described in subsection (a) in outreach
20 and communications of the Small Business Administra-
21 tion, including through publication on a website of the Ad-
22 ministration.

23 (c) BEST PRACTICES.—The Administrator shall an-
24 nually consult with the Chief Counsel for Advocacy of the
25 Office of Advocacy of the Administration to determine best

1 practices for the dissemination of other information relat-
2 ing to cybersecurity matters to small business concerns.

3 (d) ANNUAL REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
5 after, the Administrator shall submit to Congress a report
6 that includes the number and a description of small busi-
7 ness concerns that contacted the Administrator during the
8 year covered by the report with matters relating to the
9 cybersecurity of such concerns.
