

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 9718
OFFERED BY MR. WIED OF WISCONSIN**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the
following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Reshoring American
3 Manufacturing Act of 2026” or the “RAM Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. INFORMATION AND RESOURCES FOR SMALL BUSI-
5 NESS CONCERNS RELATING TO ONSHOREING
6 MANUFACTURING CAPACITY.**

7 (a) WEBPAGE REQUIRED.—Not later than 60 days
8 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Adminis-
9 trator of the Small Business Administration, acting
10 through the Associate Administrator for the Office of
11 Manufacturing and Trade of the Administration, shall es-
12 tablish and maintain a webpage containing a list of re-
13 sources and information for small business concerns (as
14 defined under section 3 of the Small Business Act (15
15 U.S.C. 632)) relating to onshoring to the United States
16 part or all of the manufacturing capacity of such concerns.

1 (b) CONTENTS.—The resources and information in-
2 cluded on the webpage required by subsection (a) shall in-
3 clude—

4 (1) contact information for general inquiries,
5 relevant offices of the Small Business Administra-
6 tion, and any partner organizations;

7 (2) a free tool designed to help small business
8 concerns identify entities that could assist with
9 onshoring to the United States the manufacturing
10 capacity of such concerns; and

11 (3) other information, as determined appro-
12 priate by the Associate Administrator for the Office
13 of Manufacturing and Trade of the Administration.

14 (c) UPDATES.—Until the date that is 4 years after
15 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Associate Ad-
16 ministrator for the Office of Manufacturing and Trade an-
17 nually shall seek input from the Chief Counsel for Advo-
18 cacy of the Office of Advocacy of the Small Business Ad-
19 ministration for improvements to the webpage and up-
20 dates to the information and resources included on such
21 webpage.

22 (d) STUDY AND REPORT.—Not later than 2 years
23 after the date on which the webpage is established, the
24 Administrator of the Small Business Administration shall
25 conduct a study and submit to Congress a report on the

1 effectiveness of the webpage required under this Act. The
2 Administrator shall submit to Congress an updated report
3 annually thereafter until the date that is 4 years after the
4 date of the enactment of this Act.

5 (e) TERMINATION.—This Act and the requirements
6 of this Act shall terminate 4 years after the date of the
7 enactment of this Act.
