John Lettieri co-founded the Economic Innovation Group and oversees the organization's efforts to study and address regional inequality and the decline of economic dynamism in the United States. John's career in public policy has included roles in the public and private sectors working with a diverse set of policymakers, economists, and private sector leaders. Prior to EIG, John was the head of public policy for a leading business association, where he led the organization's work on such issues as tax, trade, investment promotion, and manufacturing. He was previously the director of public and government affairs for a global aerospace company and served on the legislative staff of U.S. Senator Chuck Hagel.
