10 (018)	Amendment to H.R. 6093 Offered by Mr. Frost (FL) with Mr. Webster (FL)	Authorizes research and development to improve the understanding of how the public receives, interprets, and responds to and values hurricane forecasts and warnings.	Passed by voice
11 (027)	Amendment to H.R. 6093 Offered by Ms. McClellan (VA)	Includes "under-observed, underserved, or highly vulnerable populations" in post-storm community impact studies.	Passed by voice
