

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7273
OFFERED BY MS. RIVAS OF CALIFORNIA

Add at the end of title II the following:

1 **SEC. 206. TECHNOLOGY, APPROACHES, EXPERIENCES, AND**
2 **KNOWLEDGE FOR HUMAN EXPLORATION MIS-**
3 **SIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator may apply, as
5 the Administrator determines appropriate and practicable,
6 any proven robotic Mars landing technology, operational
7 approach, mission experience, or scientific knowledge of
8 NASA to advance a human exploration mission, including
9 the Moon to Mars Program established under section
10 10811(b) of subtitle A of title VII of the Research and
11 Development, Competition, and Innovation Act (enacted
12 as division B of Public Law 117–167; 51 U.S.C. 20302
13 note; popularly referred to as the “CHIPS and Science
14 Act”).

15 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
16 of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator shall sub-
17 mit to the appropriate committees of Congress a report
18 that includes information relating to the following:

19 (1) Any planned application described in sub-
20 section (a).

1 (2) Any coordination between the Science Mis-
2 sion Directorate, the Exploration Systems Develop-
3 ment Mission Directorate, and any other relevant
4 mission directorate of NASA regarding the advance-
5 ment of key technologies related to any such applica-
6 tion with respect to a human exploration mission to
7 Mars that could have applicability for robotic and
8 human exploration missions.
