Dr. Erik Lium serves as the Assistant Vice Chancellor for Innovation, Technology & Alliances at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). He has held prior positions at UCSF of Assistant Vice Chancellor of Research, Director of the Industry Contracts Division and Interim Director of the Contracts & Grants Division of the Office of Sponsored Research, and Director of Business Development for the Diabetes Center & Immune Tolerance Network. Dr. Lium was President of LabVelocity Inc., an information services company focused on accelerating life science R&D processes prior to its acquisition in 2004. He served as a postdoctoral research scientist in the laboratory of Nobel Laureate J.
