

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4186**  
**OFFERED BY MS. ESTY OF CONNECTICUT**

Page 34, after line 16, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 126 NOYCE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AMENDMENTS.**

2 (a) AMENDMENTS.—Section 10A of the National  
3 Science Foundation Authorization Act of 2002 (42 U.S.C.  
4 1862n—1a) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(2)(B), by inserting “or  
6 bachelor’s” after “master’s”;

7 (2) in subsection (c)—

8 (A) by striking “and” at the end of para-  
9 graph (2)(B);

10 (B) in paragraph (3), by—

11 (i) inserting “for teachers with mas-  
12 ter’s degrees in their field” after “Teach-  
13 ing Fellowships”; and

14 (ii) by striking the period at the end  
15 of subparagraph (B) and inserting “;  
16 and”; and

17 (C) by adding at the end the following new  
18 paragraph:

1           “(4) in the case of National Science Foundation  
2           Master Teaching Fellowships for teachers with bach-  
3           elor’s degrees in their field and working toward a  
4           master’s degree—

5           “(A) offering academic courses leading to  
6           a master’s degree and leadership training to  
7           prepare individuals to become master teachers  
8           in elementary and secondary schools; and

9           “(B) offering programs both during and  
10          after matriculation in the program for which  
11          the fellowship is received to enable fellows to  
12          become highly effective mathematics and  
13          science teachers, including mentoring, training,  
14          induction, and professional development activi-  
15          ties, to fulfill the service requirements of this  
16          section, including the requirements of sub-  
17          section (e), and to exchange ideas with others  
18          in their fields.”;

19          (3) in subsection (e), by striking “subsection  
20          (g)” and inserting “subsection (h)”; and

21          (4) by after subsection (f) the following new  
22          subsection:

23          “(g) SUPPORT FOR MASTER TEACHING FELLOWS  
24          WHILE ENROLLED IN A MASTER’S DEGREE PROGRAM.—  
25          A National Science Foundation Master Teacher Fellow

1 may receive a maximum of 1 year of fellowship support  
2 while enrolled in a master's degree program as described  
3 in subsection (c)(4)(A), except that if such fellow is en-  
4 rolled in a part-time program, such amount shall be pro-  
5 rated according to the length of the program.”.

6 (b) DEFINITION.—Section 10(i)(5) of the National  
7 Science Foundation Authorization Act of 2002 (42 U.S.C.  
8 1862n—1(i)(5)) is amended by inserting “computer  
9 science,” after “means a science,”.
