

SHORT BIOGRAPHY

Professor Marc Hillmyer received his B.S. degree in Chemistry from the University of Florida in 1989 and his Ph.D. degree in Chemistry from the California Institute of Technology in 1994. After completing a postdoctoral research position in the University of Minnesota's Department of Chemical Engineering and Materials Science he joined the Department of Chemistry faculty at Minnesota in 1997. He is currently the McKnight Presidential Endowed Chair in Chemistry and leads a research group focused on the synthesis and self-assembly of multifunctional polymers. In addition to his teaching, service, and research responsibilities, he served as an associate editor for the ACS journal *Macromolecules* from 2008–2017, and since 2018 he has been the Editor-in-Chief of *Macromolecules*. He is also the director of the Center for Sustainable Polymers a National Science Foundation Center for Chemical Innovation headquartered at the University of Minnesota.
