Diana Furchtgott-Roth, an Oxford-educated economist, is a Distinguished Fellow at the Energy Policy Research Institute. In President Trump's first term, Diana served as Deputy Assistant Secretary for Research and Technology at the U.S. Department of Transportation, where she directed the \$1.2 billion research portfolio of the Department and led the Volpe National Transportation Systems Center and the Transportation Safety Institute. She has also served in numerous other senior roles, including Acting Assistant Secretary for Economic Policy at the U.S. Department of Treasury, Chief Economist of the U.S. Department of Labor, and Chief of Staff of the Council of Economic Advisors. Diana is the author or coauthor of six books on economic policy and hundreds of articles. She is a frequent guest on TV and radio shows and writes regularly for the UK's *Daily Telegraph*.
