

Since October 1, 2013, the Arizona State Land Department (through the Arizona State Cartographer’s Office) has received two Federal Pass-through grants. These grants have since been completed.

- Broadband Technology Opportunities Program: Granted through Department of Commerce through Arizona Department of Transportation to accelerate broadband deployment in unserved and underserved areas and to ensure that strategic institutions which are likely to create jobs or provide significant public benefits have broadband connections
- E-911: Granted through Department of Transportation through Arizona Department of Transportation to work towards the migration to an IP-enabled emergency network. These activities help 911 services to more precisely determine a caller’s location.
