

## **DR. PATRICIA VALDEZ - BIO**

Dr. Patricia Valdez is the Chief Extramural Research Integrity Officer in the Office of Extramural Research (OER) at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) where she provides strategic leadership and policy direction on research integrity across the NIH extramural program. Since 2014, she has overseen policies and processes related to research security/foreign interference, research misconduct, harassment, and peer review integrity, maintaining expert knowledge of federal statutes, regulations, and evolving research oversight practices. In this role, she represents NIH at government-wide, national, and international forums in promoting research security and integrity across the research ecosystem. Before joining NIH OER, Dr. Valdez was a Staff Scientist at the NIH National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases and the Manager of Publication Ethics for the American Society for Biochemistry and Molecular Biology. Dr. Valdez received her Ph.D. in Molecular and Cell Biology from the University of California, Berkeley and carried out her postdoctoral training at Genentech.
