Re: Hearing on “Oversight of CDC Policies and Decisions During the COVID-19 Pandemic”

On **Tuesday, June 13, 2023, at 10:30 AM ET in room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building**, the Select Subcommittee on the Coronavirus Pandemic will hold a hearing titled “Oversight of CDC Policies and Decisions During the COVID-19 Pandemic.”
