A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds to implement any obligations of the United States under the World Health Organization’s Global Pandemic Treaty.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting American
5 Sovereignty Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FUNDS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—No funds available to any Federal
8 department or agency may be used to implement any obli-

1 gations of the United States under the World Health Or-
2 ganization’s Global Pandemic Treaty.

3 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “World
4 Health Organization’s Global Pandemic Treaty” means
5 the Zero draft report by the Working Group on Strength-
6 ening WHO Preparedness and Response to Health Emer-
7 gencies, and any related or successor reports and rec-
8 ommendations regarding pandemics as created by the
9 World Health Organization.
