

**Holden Thorp, Ph.D.**

Dr. Thorp became Editor-in-Chief of the *Science* family of journals on 28 October 2019. He also holds faculty appointments in chemistry and medicine at The George Washington University. He came to *Science* from Washington University in St. Louis, where he was provost and Rita Levi-Montalcini Distinguished University Professor from 2013 to 2019. He joined Washington University after spending three decades at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (UNC), where he served as the 10th chancellor from 2008 to 2013.

A North Carolina native, Dr. Thorp started at UNC as an undergraduate student and earned a bachelor of

science degree in chemistry in 1986. He earned a doctorate in chemistry in 1989 at the California Institute of Technology. He holds an honorary doctor of laws degree from North Carolina Wesleyan College, is a member of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, and is a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the National Academy of Inventors.

Dr. Thorp is the coauthor, with Buck Goldstein, of two books on higher education: *Engines of Innovation*:

*The Entrepreneurial University in the Twenty-First Century* and *Our Higher Calling: Rebuilding the Partnership Between America and its Colleges and Universities*, both from UNC Press.
