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Dr. David Carroll is the Acting Deputy Chief Consultant for Specialty Mental Health within the Office of Patient Care Services. He leads the teams responsible for policy and program guidance related to suicide prevention, posttraumatic stress disorder, substance use disorders, military sexual trauma, women's mental health, family services, VA/DoD integrated mental health care, and community engagement. He is the acting lead within Mental Health Services for the Mental Illness Research, Education, and Clinical Centers and the mental health Centers of Excellence, including the National Center for Posttraumatic Stress Disorder.

Dr. Carroll has held multiple clinical and supervisory positions since joining VHA in 1990. He began his career as the Staff Psychologist for Geriatrics and Extended Care at the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee where he went on to serve in several leadership roles including Program Manager of the Mental Health Residential Rehabilitation Treatment Program, Lead Psychologist, and Co-Chair of the Medical Center's Ethics Council. Dr. Carroll joined Mental Health Services at Central Office in 2007 as the Director of Recovery Services. From 2011 to 2012, he was the Lead for the VHA major initiative to improve Veterans' mental health. He has served in numerous other leadership roles within VHA and in the community. He is an assistant clinical professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Medicine at the Medical College of Wisconsin.
