1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Veteran Urgent Access
3	to Mental Healthcare Act".
4	SEC. 2. EXPANSION OF INITIAL AND URGENT MENTAL
5	HEALTH CARE FOR CERTAIN FORMER MEM-
6	BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.
7	(a) In General.—Chapter 17 of title 38, United
8	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1720H
9	the following new section:
10	"§ 1720I. Provision of initial and urgent mental
11	health care for certain former members
12	not otherwise eligible for care
13	"(a) In General.—The Secretary shall furnish to
14	former members of the Armed Forces described in sub-
15	section (b)—
16	"(1) an initial mental health assessment; and
17	"(2) the mental health care services authorized

1	required to treat the urgent mental health care
2	needs of the former member, including risk of sui-
3	cide or harming others.
4	"(b) Former Members of the Armed Forces
5	DESCRIBED.—A former member of the Armed Forces de-
6	scribed in this subsection is an individual who meets the
7	following criteria:
8	"(1) The individual is a former member of the
9	Armed Forces, including the reserve components,
10	who—
11	"(A) served in the active military, naval, or
12	air service, and was discharged or released
13	therefrom under a condition that is not honor-
14	able except—
15	"(i) dishonorable; or
16	"(ii) bad conduct discharge;
17	"(B) has applied for a character of service
18	determination and such determination has not
19	been made; and
20	"(C) is not otherwise eligible to enroll in
21	the health care system established by section
22	1705 of this title by reason of such discharge
23	or release not meeting the requirements of sec-
24	tion 101(2) of this title.
25	"(2) While serving in the Armed Forces—

1	"(A) the former member was deployed in a
2	theater of combat operations or an area at a
3	time during which hostilities occurred in that
4	area;
5	"(B) participated in or experienced such
6	combat operations or hostilities, including by
7	controlling an unmanned aerial vehicle from a
8	location other than such theater or area; or
9	"(C) was the victim of a physical assault
10	of a sexual nature, battery of a sexual nature,
11	or sexual harassment (as defined in section
12	1720D(f) of this title).
13	"(c) Non-Department Care.—(1) In furnishing
14	mental health care services to an individual under this sec-
15	tion, the Secretary may provide such mental health care
16	services at a non-Department facility if—
17	"(A) in the judgment of a mental health profes-
18	sional employed by the Department, the receipt of
19	mental health care services by that individual in fa-
20	cilities of the Department would be clinically inadvis-
21	able; or
22	"(B) facilities of the Department are not capa-
23	ble of furnishing such mental health care services to
24	that individual economically because of geographical
25	inaccessibility.

1	"(2) The Secretary shall carry out paragraph (1) pur-
2	suant to section 1703 of this title or any other provision
3	of law authorizing the Secretary to enter into contracts
4	or agreements to furnish hospital care and medical serv-
5	ices to veterans at non-Department facilities.
6	"(d) Setting and Referrals.—In furnishing men-
7	tal health care services to an individual under this section,
8	the Secretary shall—
9	"(1) seek to ensure that such mental health
10	care services are furnished in a setting that is thera-
11	peutically appropriate, taking into account the cir-
12	cumstances that resulted in the need for such men-
13	tal health care services; and
14	"(2) provide referral services to assist former
15	members who are not eligible for services under this
16	chapter to obtain services from sources outside the
17	Department.
18	"(e) Information.—The Secretary shall provide in-
19	formation on the mental health care services available
20	under this section. Efforts by the Secretary to provide
21	such information—
22	"(1) shall include availability of a toll-free tele-
23	phone number (commonly referred to as an 800
24	number):

1	"(2) shall ensure that information about the
2	mental health care services available under this sec-
3	tion—
4	"(A) is revised and updated as appro-
5	priate;
6	"(B) is made available and visibly posted
7	at appropriate facilities of the Department; and
8	"(C) is made available through appropriate
9	public information services; and
10	"(3) shall include coordination with the Sec-
11	retary of Defense seeking to ensure that members of
12	the Armed Forces and individuals who are being
13	separated from active military, naval, or air service
14	are provided appropriate information about pro-
15	grams, requirements, and procedures for applying
16	for mental health care services under this section.
17	"(f) Annual Reports.—Each year, the Secretary
18	shall submit to Congress an annual report on the mental
19	health care services provided pursuant to this section.
20	Each report shall include data for the year covered by the
21	report with respect to each of the following:
22	"(1) The number of individuals who received
23	mental health care services under subsection (a),
24	disaggregated by the number of men who received

1	such services and the number of women who re-
2	ceived such services.
3	"(2) Such other information as the Secretary
4	considers appropriate.".
5	(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
6	at the beginning of chapter 17 of title 38, United States
7	Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
8	section 1720H the following new item:
	"1720I. Provision of initial and urgent mental health care not otherwise eligible for care.".
9	(c) STUDY ON EFFECT OF COMBAT SERVICE ON SUI-
10	CIDE RATES.—
11	(1) Study.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs,
12	in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, shall
13	seek to enter into a contract with an independent
14	nongovernmental entity to carry out a study on the
15	effect combat service has had on suicide rates and
16	serious mental health issues among veterans. To the
17	extent practicable, such study shall—
18	(A) compare the rate and method of sui-
19	cides among veterans who have received mental
20	health care services from the Veterans Health
21	Administration and veterans who have not re-
22	ceived such services from the Veterans Health
23	Administration; and

1	(B) compare the rate and method of sui-
2	cides and the incidence of serious mental health
3	issues among veterans who have served in com-
4	bat and veterans who have not served in com-
5	bat.
6	(2) Report.—Not later than one year after the
7	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
8	Veterans Affairs shall submit to Congress a report
9	containing the study conducted under paragraph (1).

17	(a) In General.—Chapter 53 of title 38, United
18	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 5303A
19	the following new section:
20	"§ 5303B. Character of service determinations
21	"(a) Determination.—The Secretary shall estab-
22	lish a process by which an individual who served in the
23	Armed Forces and was discharged or dismissed therefrom
24	may seek a determination from the Secretary with respect
25	to whether such discharge or release was under a condition

- 1 that bars the right of such individual to a benefit under
- 2 the laws administered by the Secretary based upon the pe-
- 3 riod of service from which discharged or dismissed.
- 4 "(b) Provision of Information.—If the Secretary
- 5 determines under subsection (a) that an individual is
- 6 barred to a benefit under the laws administered by the
- 7 Secretary, the Secretary shall provide to such individual
- 8 information regarding the ability of the individual to ad-
- 9 dress such condition, including pursuant to section 5303
- 10 of this title and chapter 79 of title 10.".
