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1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Department of Vet-
3	erans Affairs Bonus Transparency Act".
4	SEC. 2. ANNUAL REPORT ON PERFORMANCE AWARDS AND
5	BONUSES AWARDED TO CERTAIN HIGH-
6	LEVEL EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF

8	(a) In General.—Chapter 7 of title 38, United
9	States Code, is amended by inserting after section 717 the

14	"(a) In General.—Not later than 120 days after
15	the end of each fiscal year, the Secretary shall submit to

section (a) shall include the following with respect to each

3	"(1) The amount of each award or bonus.
4	"(2) The job title of the individual awarded the
5	award or bonus.
6	"(3) The location where the individual awarded
7	the award or bonus works.
8	"(c) Definitions.—In this section:
9	"(1) The term 'appropriate committees of Con-
10	gress' means—
11	"(A) the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
12	and the Committee on Appropriations of the
13	Senate; and
14	"(B) the Committee on Veterans' Affairs
15	and the Committee on Appropriations of the
16	House of Representatives.
17	"(2) The term 'individual' means—
18	"(A) a career appointee (as that term is
19	defined in section 3132(a)(4) of title 5); or
20	"(B) any individual who occupies an ad-
21	ministrative or executive position and who was
22	appointed under section 7306(a) or section
23	7401(1) of this title.
