

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE  
TO H.R. 1900  
OFFERED BY MR. ROE OF TENNESSEE**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “National Veterans Me-  
3 morial and Museum Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL VETERANS MEMORIAL  
5                                   AND MUSEUM.**

6       (a) DESIGNATION.—Subject to the condition de-  
7 scribed in subsection (b), the memorial and museum that  
8 is, as of the date of the enactment of this Act, being con-  
9 structed on an approximately 7-acre area on West Broad  
10 Street, Columbus, Ohio, bounded by the Scioto River and  
11 the Scioto Greenway, shall be designated as the “National  
12 Veterans Memorial and Museum”.

13       (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—

14           (1) IN GENERAL.—As a condition of the des-  
15 igation under subsection (a), the director of the  
16 memorial and museum described in that subsection  
17 shall submit to Congress a report on the memorial  
18 and museum by not later than the date specified in

1 paragraph (2). Such report shall include each of the  
2 following:

3 (A) The projected budget for the memorial  
4 and museum for the five-year period beginning  
5 on the date the memorial and museum is ex-  
6 pected to open to the public.

7 (B) A description of the outreach con-  
8 ducted by the memorial and museum to vet-  
9 erans across the United States to receive input  
10 about the design and contents of the memorial  
11 and museum.

12 (C) A description of the process by which  
13 decisions are made about the contents of the ex-  
14 hibits displayed at the memorial and museum.

15 (D) A description of the organizational  
16 structure of the memorial and museum.

17 (E) A copy of the bylaws and rules of the  
18 memorial and museum.

19 (F) A list of any organizations or entities  
20 that have accredited the memorial and museum.

21 (2) DEADLINE FOR REPORT.—The date speci-  
22 fied in this paragraph is the earlier of the following  
23 dates:

24 (A) The date that is 90 days after the date  
25 of the enactment of this Act.

1                   (B) The date that is 30 days before the  
2                   date on which the memorial and museum is  
3                   first open to the public.

4           (c) EFFECT OF DESIGNATION.—The national memo-  
5 rial and museum designated by subsection (a) is not a unit  
6 of the National Park System, and the designation of the  
7 national memorial and museum shall not be construed to  
8 require Federal funds to be expended for any purpose re-  
9 lated to the national memorial and museum.
