## AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 4635

## OFFERED BY MR. COFFMAN OF COLORADO

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1	SECTION 1. PEER SUPPORT COUNSELING PROGRAM FOR
2	WOMEN VETERANS.
3	(a) In General.—Section 1720F(j) of title 38,
4	United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
5	following new paragraph:
6	"(4)(A) As part of the counseling program under this
7	subsection, the Secretary shall emphasize appointing peer
8	support counselors for women veterans. To the degree
9	practicable, the Secretary shall seek to recruit women peer
10	support counselors with expertise in—
11	"(i) female gender-specific issues and services;
12	"(ii) the provision of information about services
13	and benefits provided under laws administered by
14	the Secretary; or
15	"(iii) employment mentoring.
16	"(B) To the degree practicable, the Secretary shall
17	emphasize facilitating peer support counseling for women
18	veterans who are eligible for counseling and services under

- 1 section 1720D of this title, have post-traumatic stress dis-
- 2 order or suffer from another mental health condition, are
- 3 homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, or are otherwise
- 4 at increased risk of suicide, as determined by the Sec-
- 5 retary.
- 6 "(C) The Secretary shall conduct outreach to inform
- 7 women veterans about the program and the assistance
- 8 available under this paragraph.
- 9 "(D) In carrying out this paragraph, the Secretary
- 10 shall coordinate with such community organizations, State
- 11 and local governments, institutions of higher education,
- 12 chambers of commerce, local business organizations, orga-
- 13 nizations that provide legal assistance, and other organiza-
- 14 tions as the Secretary considers appropriate.
- 15 "(E) In carrying out this paragraph, the Secretary
- 16 shall provide adequate training for peer support coun-
- 17 selors, including training carried out under the national
- 18 program of training required by section 304(c) of the
- 19 Caregivers and Veterans Omnibus Health Services Act of
- 20 2010 (38 U.S.C. 1712A note).".
- 21 (b) Funding.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
- 22 shall carry out paragraph (4) of section 1720F(j) of title
- 23 38, United States Code, as added by subsection (a), using
- 24 funds otherwise made available to the Secretary. No addi-

- 1 tional funds are authorized to be appropriated by reason
- 2 of such paragraph.
- 3 (c) Report to Congress.—Not later than two
- 4 years after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
- 5 retary of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees
- 6 on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-
- 7 resentatives a report on the peer support counseling pro-
- 8 gram under section 1720F(j) of title 38, United States
- 9 Code, as amended by this section. Such report shall in-
- 10 clude—
- 11 (1) the number of peer support counselors in
- the program;
- 13 (2) an assessment of the effectiveness of the
- 14 program; and
- 15 (3) a description of the oversight of the pro-
- 16 gram.
