3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Lethal Means Safety5 Training Act".

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1SEC. 2. SUICIDE RISK MANAGEMENT AND PREVENTION2AND LETHAL MEANS TRAINING.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—

4 (1) INITIAL UPDATE.—Not later than 180 days 5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-6 retary of Veterans Affairs, in consultation with enti-7 ties described in subsection (c), shall update the Le-8 thal Means Safety and Suicide Prevention training 9 course of the Department of Veterans Affairs to en-10 sure that it is culturally appropriate and uses best practices identified by appropriate subject matter ex-11 12 perts.

13 (2)SUBSEQUENT UPDATES.—Not less fre-14 quently than once each year, the Secretary shall up-15 date the training as appropriate, taking into consid-16 eration best practices, and publish a report on the 17 internet website of the Department that includes the 18 percentage of individuals in each category described 19 in paragraphs (2), (3), and (4) of subsection (b) who 20 completed the training referred to in paragraph (1)21 during the year covered by the report.

22	ployee of such provider who provides such care to
23	take the most recently updated version of the train-
