3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "VA Mental Health5 Staffing Act".

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1SEC. 2. STAFFING IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR MENTAL2HEALTH PROVIDERS OF DEPARTMENT OF3VETERANS AFFAIRS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than one year after the 5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, in consultation with the Inspector General 6 7 of the Department of Veterans Affairs, shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and the 8 9 Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the House of Rep-10 resentatives a plan to address staffing of mental health 11 providers of the Department of Veterans Affairs, including 12 filling any open positions.

13 (b) ELEMENTS.—The plan required by subsection (a)14 shall include the following:

(1) An estimate of the number of positions for
mental health providers of the Department that need
to be filled to meet demand.

18 (2) An identification of the steps that the Sec19 retary will take to address mental health staffing for
20 the Department.

(3) A description of any region-specific hiring
incentives to be used by the Secretary in consultation with the directors of Veterans Integrated Service Networks and medical centers of the Department.

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(4) A description of any local retention or en gagement incentives to be used by directors of Vet erans Integrated Service Networks.

(5) Such recommendations for legislative or administrative action as the Secretary considers necessary to aid in addressing mental health staffing for the Department.

8 (c) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the sub-9 mittal of the plan required by subsection (a), the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the 10 11 Senate and the Committee on Veterans' Affairs of the 12 House of Representatives a report setting forth the num-13 ber of mental health providers hired by the Department 14 during the one-year period preceding the submittal of the 15 report.
