Sam Jackson is an assistant professor in the College of Emergency Preparedness, Homeland Security and Cybersecurity at the University at Albany. His research focuses on antigovernment extremism in the U.S., conspiracy theories, extremism online, and contentious activity on the internet more broadly. His book, *Oath Keepers: Patriotism and the Edge of Violence in a Right-Wing Antigovernment Group*, was published by Columbia University Press in 2020. His research has been published in academic journals including *Terrorism and Political Violence; Media, War, and Conflict;* and *Dynamics of Asymmetric Conflict.* He has also spoken on political extremism to law enforcement, intelligence, and military audiences.
