## AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 3848

## OFFERED BY MR. BOST OF ILLINOIS

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

## SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act may be cited as the "Housing our Military 2 Veterans Effectively Act of 2023" or the "HOME Act of 2023". SEC. 2.
