Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Review Every Veterans
3	Claim Act of 2023".
4	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DENIAL OF CLAIMS FOR BENE-
5	FITS UNDER LAWS ADMINISTERED BY SEC-
6	RETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS ON SOLE
7	BASIS THAT VETERAN FAILED TO APPEAR
8	FOR CERTAIN MEDICAL EXAMINATION.
9	Subsection (d) of section 5103A of title 38, United
10	States Code, is amended—
11	(1) in the heading, by striking "Compensation
12	CLAIMS" and inserting "CLAIMS FOR BENEFITS";
13	(2) in paragraph (2), by striking "treat an ex-
14	amination or opinion as being necessary to make a
15	decision on a claim for purposes of" and inserting
16	"provide for a medical examination or obtain a med-
17	ical opinion under"; and

1	(3) by adding at the end the following new
2	paragraph:
3	"(3) If a veteran fails to appear for a medical exam-
4	ination provided by the Secretary in conjunction with a
5	claim for a benefit under a law administered by the Sec-
6	retary, the Secretary may not deny such claim on the sole
7	basis that such veteran failed to appear for such medical
8	examination.".
9	SEC. 3. BOARD OF VETERANS' APPEALS: JURISDICTION;
10	ELEMENTS OF DECISIONS.
11	(a) Jurisdiction.—Section 7104 of title 38, United
12	States Code, is amended, in subsection (a)—
13	(1) by inserting "(1)" before "All questions";
14	and
15	(2) by adding at the end the following new
16	paragraphs:
17	"(2) The Board shall determine, in the first instance,
18	whether the Board has jurisdiction regarding a matter.
19	"(3) If the Board, on its own initiative, raises a ques-
20	tion of a potential jurisdictional defect, the Board shall
21	notify the parties and allow the parties an opportunity to
22	respond.".
23	(b) Elements of Decisions.—Subsection (d) of
24	such section is amended as follows:
25	(1) In paragraph (2)—

1	(A) in subparagraphs (A) and (B), by
2	striking "; and" both places it appears and in-
3	serting a semicolon;
4	(B) by redesignating subparagraph (B), as
5	amended, as subparagraph (C); and
6	(C) by inserting, after subparagraph (A),
7	the following new subparagraph (B):
8	"(B) if such evidence was not considered
9	as described in subparagraph (A), identifying
10	the time when such evidence was received and
11	the provision of section 7113 of this title that
12	establishes that such evidence may not be re-
13	ceived at such time; and".
14	(2) By redesignating paragraph (3) as para-
15	graph (4).
16	(3) By inserting, after paragraph (2), the fol-
17	lowing new paragraph (3):
18	"(3) the written determination of the Board
19	whether the notice of disagreement was adequate
20	and timely filed under section 7105 of this title;
21	and".
22	(c) Conforming Amendment.—Section 7105 of
23	such title is amended by striking subparagraph (C) of
24	paragraph (1) of subsection (b).

1	SEC. 4. BOARD OF VETERANS' APPEALS PUBLICATION OF
2	DATES OF DOCKET ACTIVITY.
3	Section 7107 of title 38, United States Code, is
4	amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
5	section:
6	"(f) Publication of Expected Actions.—(1) On
7	a weekly basis, for each docket, the Board shall publish,
8	on a website of the Department, notice of the docket dates
9	of the cases assigned to a Board member for a decision
10	for that week.
11	"(2) Each notice published under paragraph (1) shall
12	include a statement that an assignment described in such
13	paragraph does not require the Board to issue a decision
14	regarding the case during such week.
15	"(3) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to a case—
16	"(A) that has been advanced under subsection
17	(b); or
18	"(B) remanded by the United States Court of
19	Appeals for Veterans Claims.".
20	SEC. 5. MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN HOUSING LOAN FEES.
21	The loan fee table in section 3729(b)(2) of title 38,
22	United States Code, is amended by striking "November
23	15, 2031" each place it appears and inserting "November
24	22, 2031".
