1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Education
3	Transparency and Training Act" or the "VETT Act".
4	SEC. 2. PROCESSES TO APPROVE PROGRAMS OF EDU-
5	CATION FOR PURPOSES OF THE EDU-
6	CATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS OF THE
7	DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.
8	(a) Limitation of Disapproval of Programs of
9	EDUCATION FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE CERTAIN
10	Forms.—Section 3679(f)(5) of title 38, United States
11	Code, is amended—
12	(1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "this para-
13	graph" and inserting "this subparagraph";
14	(2) in subparagraph (B), by striking "this para-
15	graph" and inserting "subparagraph (A)"; and
16	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
17	paragraph:

1	"(C) If an educational institution cannot provide to
2	an individual a form under paragraph (1) that contains
3	all of the information required under subparagraph (A)
4	of such paragraph, the educational institution shall pro-
5	vide to such individual, with the form under such para-
6	graph, a notice—
7	"(i) that specifies what such information may
8	be inaccurate or incomplete; and
9	"(ii) that includes, in place of the information
10	that may be inaccurate or incomplete, the best esti-
11	mate available on the date of such notice.".
12	(b) Publication of Information About Train-
13	ING FOR SCHOOL CERTIFYING OFFICIALS.—The Sec-
14	retary of Veterans Affairs shall establish a website to serve
15	as a central location for the publication of information
16	about the training that the Department of Veterans Af-
17	fairs provides for school certifying officials and shall up-
18	date such information on a regular basis.
19	SEC. 3. MODIFICATION OF RULES FOR APPROVAL OF COM-
20	MERCIAL DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAMS
21	FOR PURPOSES OF EDUCATIONAL ASSIST-
22	ANCE PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
23	VETERANS AFFAIRS.
24	(a) In General.—Section 3680A(e) of title 38,
25	United States Code, is amended—

1	(1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
2	(3) as subparagraphs (A) though (C), respectively;
3	(2) in the matter before subparagraph (A), as
4	redesignated by paragraph (1), by inserting "(1)"
5	before "The Secretary";
6	(3) in paragraph (1)(B), as redesignated by
7	paragraph (1), by inserting "except as provided in
8	paragraph (2)," before "the course"; and
9	(4) by adding at the end the following new
10	paragraph (2):
11	"(2)(A) Subject to this paragraph, a commercial driv-
12	er education program is exempt from paragraph (1)(B)
13	for a branch of an educational institution if the commer-
14	cial driver education program offered at the branch by the
15	educational institution—
16	"(i) is appropriately licensed; and
17	"(ii)(I) the branch is located in a State in
18	which the same commercial driver education pro-
19	gram is offered by the same educational institution
20	at another branch of that educational institution in
21	the same State that is approved for purposes of this
22	chapter by a State approving agency or the Sec-
23	retary when acting in the role of a State approving
24	agency; or

1	"(II)(aa) the branch is located in a State in
2	which the same commercial driver education pro-
3	gram is not offered at another branch of the same
4	educational institution in the same State; and
5	"(bb) the branch has been operating for a pe-
6	riod of at least one year using the same curriculum
7	as a commercial driver education program offered by
8	the educational institution at another location that is
9	approved for purposes of this chapter by a State ap-
10	proving agency or the Secretary when acting in the
11	role of a State approving agency.
12	"(B)(i) In order for a commercial driver education
13	program of an educational institution offered at a branch
14	described in paragraph (1)(B) to be exempt under sub-
15	paragraph (A) of this paragraph, the educational institu-
16	tion shall submit to the Secretary each year that para-
17	graph (1)(B) would otherwise apply a report that dem-
18	onstrates that the curriculum at the new branch is the
19	same as the curriculum at the primary location.
20	"(ii) Reporting under clause (i) shall be submitted
21	in accordance with such requirements as the Secretary
22	shall establish in consultation with the State approving
23	agencies.
24	"(C)(i) The Secretary may withhold an exemption
25	under subparagraph (A) for any educational institution or

branch of an educational institution as the Secretary con-2 siders appropriate. 3 "(ii) In making any determination under clause (i), the Secretary may consult with the Secretary of Transportation on the performance of a provider of a commercial driver program, including the status of the provider within the Training Provider Registry of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration when appropriate. 8 9 "(D) The Secretary shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-10 resentatives a notification not later than 30 days after the 12 Secretary grants an exemption under this paragraph. Such notification shall identify the educational institution 13 14 and branch of such educational institution granted such 15 exemption.". 16 (b) Implementation.— 17 (1) Establishment of requirements.—Not 18 later than 180 days after the date of the enactment 19 of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall 20 establish requirements under section 21 3680A(e)(2)(B)(ii) of such title, as added by sub-22 section (a). 23 (2) RULEMAKING.—In promulgating any rules 24 to carry out paragraph (2) of section 3680A(e) of 25 title 38, United States Code, as added by subsection

(a), the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall consult 1 2 with State approving agencies. (3) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made 3 by subsection (a) shall apply to commercial driver 4 education programs on and after the day that is 180 5 6 days after the date on which the Secretary establishes the requirements under paragraph (1) of this 7 8 subsection.
